There are some crazy hats to be found within the Gallery's artworks. Make your own over-the-top creation using an empty egg tray and wear it with pride!

Tohutohu | Instructions

- 1 Play around with an empty egg tray – decide how you want it to sit on your head. Do you prefer it on one side, flat or upright?
- 2 Work out where the string needs to go, so that the tray will stay on your head just where you want it. Then make small holes in the egg tray and attach the string.
- 3 Use whatever materials you can find at home to make flowers, add strips of paper, pompoms, pipe cleaners etc to decorate your eggstravagant hat.
- 4 Imagine your portrait is being painted by a famous artist and take photos of you posing in your hat.
