THE HISTORY


Queens Wharf lies at the foot of Queen Street and has always been a focal point of the waterfront, due to its central city location. Completed in 1913, Queens Wharf played an important role in the transport corridors that connected the city with both local and international ports – being the hub through which goods were exported and imported, and people arrived and departed. Purchased in 2009 for the people of Auckland, Queens Wharf represents an important part of Auckland's history – and future.

THE LOCATION

Conveniently located next to the ferry terminal and opposite Britomart Transport Centre, Queens Wharf is easily accessible to all visitors. In the heart of the Auckland CBD, it is within walking distance of countless hotels, shopping and dining options.



SHEDS 10


Built in 1910, Shed 10 is the only original building that remains on Queens Wharf. The shed is a heritage-listed building that for much of its life was used to store cargo on Queens Wharf before it was shipped overseas.

Shed 10 has undergone a thoughtful restoration that retains the heritage elements you'd expect in a unique premium events space.

The ground floor retains the shed's robust industrial character with a concrete floor, steel columns and exposed beams. The upper floor is warm and rich in character and detail, with timber flooring, exposed steel trusses and a gable ceiling with occasional skylights.

SHED 10 GROUND FLOOR

At over 2200m² the ground floor is a flexible space, suitable for exhibitions, fashion shows, gala dinners and product launches.



SHED 10 LEVEL 1

From a light and airy atrium space, level 1 of Shed 10 opens out to reveal a spacious floor with windows on both ends overlooking the Waitematā Harbour and back to the city.



The Cloud

The Cloud is a unique, modern structure that has quickly become a landmark along Auckland's waterfront. Designed by Jasmax, The Cloud reflects Aotearoa, land of the long white cloud. The Cloud was erected as a temporary structure to accommodate Auckland's commitment to host an inner-city Fanzone during the Rugby World Cup 2011, and has since won a place in the hearts of Aucklanders.



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The Cloud

EXHIBITION FLOOR

With a length of almost 180 metres, the ground floor is ideal for exhibitions, gala dinners, showcases, product launches and fashion events.



LOWER MEZZANINE

With doors that open out on the northern end of Queens Wharf, the lower mezzanine is suitable for cocktail events and banquets, and enables your event to flow easily onto the waterfront.





OUTSIDE SPACES

Queens Wharf lies at the foot of Queen Street in the heart of downtown Auckland. With large open spaces, the outdoor area of the wharf is available for hire, either as an extension of events taking place in The Cloud and Shed 10, or for stand-alone outdoor events.





VENUE INFORMATION

Venue Hire

Both The Cloud and Shed 10 at Queens Wharf are available to hire from Auckland Live. For both of these venues you will need to bring in all your event requirements, from audio visual through to catering equipment.

Catering

Auckland Live has a list of excellent catering companies available who would be more than happy to provide menus and quotes for your event. When discussing your venue booking with Auckland Live please let us know if you would like to receive information on catering.

Beverage

Queens Wharf is not licensed for alcohol. When discussing your event with your chosen caterer please ensure they hold a current on-license and a caterer's license. If you are not using a caterer and wish to serve alcohol you will need to obtain the applicable liquor license permits.

Audio Visual Services

From lighting design to audio visual support, our technical team offers the experience and technical capability to turn your creative vision into reality.

Vehicle Parking

There is no public parking on Queens Wharf. However, there are limited parking spaces available for the event organiser. The closest public parking is available at Britomart (britomart.org/parking) and Downtown carparks (at.govt.nz).

Noise Restrictions

There are noise restrictions on Queens Wharf; these are strictly enforced and no noise may go above the allocated limits. Fines will be applied for any events that breach these noise restrictions and limits. More details on noise restrictions are available on application.

Smoking Policy

All Auckland Live venues are smoke free. There are designated external areas at Queens Wharf where smoking is permitted.

Other Charges

In addition to the venue hire, other charges will apply including power, gas, cleaning, security, smoke isolation and the services of our venue representatives for the duration of your stay on site. When booking your event please request an estimate for all your event costs.
